### Mizuno Lone Star Classic National Qualifier

LSC is the largest of the 12 junior national qualifiers sanctioned by USA Volleyball (USAV), the national governing body for the sport of volleyball. At over 1,800 teams in 2019, it is not only the nation's largest qualifier tournament, but also the largest three-day volleyball event in the world. Teams compete in hopes of attaining a bid to USAV's Girls' Junior National Championships. Hosted over multiple weekends in the Dallas Convention Center, LSC sets a higher standard by offering many outstanding tournament features such as expanded divisions, a boys' tournament, parents' lounge and kid's zone.

#### **Tour of Texas**

The Tour of Texas Qualifier is the largest regional tournament in the state of Texas and hosted in San Antonio, Houston, and Dallas. The tournament acts as a qualifier for the Tour of Texas, hosting the state's most competitive teams. The tour consists of the qualifier tournaments and two stops in Austin and Dallas.

Sanctioned by the Lone Star Region as the region's championship, LSR is the last chance opportunity for teams to qualify for the USA Volleyball Girls' Junior National Championships. LSR will be hosted in Houston, TX and crowns the region's best teams.
