

Important Tour of Texas Warm Up Information

***Forward this email and attachments to all players/families attending the Tour Warm Up ***

1 coach per team must stay in the building at all time. This is so that the tournament director can notify coaches when their team is scheduled to play next.

* Doors will open at 7am both days. Match start times are indicated online. The schedule is subject to change if teams drop due to COVID. Coaches, athletes and the 1 team parent will be allowed entry into the gym.

Team Check-In

All teams must check-in online prior to their first match. There will be no on-site check-in and no paper copies will be accepted at the event. A cell phone number of a coach onsite must be entered. \rightarrow Check- In Instructions

We understand that there have been complications in AES related to region and roster requirements. Please let us know if you are having issues, we will work with you onsite before matches begin if there are issues.

Spectator Information

Ticketing is **ONLINE** and **CASHLESS**. **PHOTO ID** and **TICKET** must be presented for facility entry **EVERY TIME**. Tickets are available online through <u>Ticket Guru by Sport Wrench</u>.

Due to COVID restrictions, our policies have become stricter to enable contact tracing and spectator limitations. Tickets are issued individually by attendee name and are not shareable or transferrable.

Each team is limited to 1 parent per team. Same parent for both days of the tournament. Our priority is to give athletes the opportunity to safely play this season. Temperatures will be taken, and wristbands will be handed out to indicate this. Wristbands must be worn to re-enter the venue.

Entrance and Exits

- **SMAC:** both buildings will be used. Enter and exit the buildings as normal.
- **ASC CP:** enter through the front doors. Exit using the doors around the gym playing area. They are clearly marked.

COVID-19 Health and Safety

The abuse of the following protocols will result in removal from the venue. There is a zero-tolerance policy for putting the health of others at risk. By attending a Lone Star Region event, participants and spectators assume risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

- No one attending the event should:
 - Be waiting for the results of a COVID test
 - Have had symptoms in the past 24 hours
 - $\circ~$ Been in close contact with another person that has tested positive for COVID 7-10 days before the tournament
- Masks are required at all times for all event locations.
- Temperatures will be taken before entering the SMAC or ASC CP facilities.
- Do not enter the building more than 30 minutes prior to your match. If a court is behind, please be patient.
- Teams that are not playing or refereeing need to be outside the building. The coach and team parent can stay in the building to monitor court schedule and match progress.
- Coaches are responsible for monitoring match progress and ensuring their team is on time to matches and officiating duties.
- Team meetings cannot occur in the building after matches due to capacity restrictions.
- Teams cannot warm up in open areas. Warm up must be on the court when you are scheduled to play.
- Each team should bring their own ball bag for warm up.
- Electronic hand whistles are strongly encouraged. You must wear a mask to blow into a whistle <u>NO</u> <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>.
- Remind teams to bring their own hand sanitizer and an extra mask!
